The 2016 Bernon Bécot offers floral/violet and iris scents on the nose that might not possess quite the same delineation as other Puisseguin Saint Emilion 2016s that I encountered, but it is still enjoyable. The palate is medium-bodied with chewy tannin, good depth of fruit with just the right amount of bitterness on the finish to beckon you back. Give it two or three years in bottle.
